THE PARING PINOT NOIR 2013:

A study of young and old vines.

MATT DEES' WINEMAKER NOTES:

Floral and perfumed nose of roses and fresh strawberries. Underlying the brightness on the nose, is a wine of earthy power and complexity; the perfect combination for pinot noir. Ripe raspberry fruit and hibiscus tea on the velvet palate along with subtle smoke, anise and pepper spice. Fine, dusty tannins and freshness from vibrant acidity on the finish. A wine that speaks volumes about the bright sunshine of the vintage and the deep roots of our mature vines.
